Legislative – Legislation has been introduced by Representatives Mary Felzkowski (Czaja), Rob Swearingen, and Senator Sheila Harsdorf to eliminate the 2019 year sunset clause of the trail pass and increase the maintenance money to the clubs to maintain our snowmobile trails. The AWSC has worked with the legislative sponsors to draft this legislation and now needs to have our members contact their Senators and Representatives to support LRB-2237. The trail pass has generated over \$2 million for the snowmobile program and we need LRB-2237 to protect the trail pass. Please contact your state Representatives and Senators to support and pass LRB-2237.
