Minutes: Motion by Dan Mier, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Sharon Partl, to approve minutes as mailed. Passed.

President's Report: Slug stated the trails north of Lake Noquebay were groomed and are in fair condition. Trails from Wausaukee west and north are in good condition. Use caution as the corners are icy.

Treasurer's Report: The monthly financial report was given by Andy. Motion by Jack Zore, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mack McKim, to accept the report. Passed.

Committee Reports: Alliance – The clubs discussed the difference between the GPS recorded funded and unfunded miles of trail. The Marinette County Recreation Officer (Zak Albrecht) reported on his activities of the job. He will be patrolling with a snowmobile and ATV.

Legislative – Andy reported on the AWSC Director meeting held in Rick Lake, Wisconsin. The AWSC is starting to set up a meeting with the new administration in the state. Blue Mound State Park trail, Stover 7 Lake trail in Polk County, and Wolf River trail in Langlade County are issues being challenged. The Directors approved a bylaw change making the AWSC membership period running July 1 to June 30 the same as the trail pass period. The bylaw will be presented to the membership at the convention in March. The Directors also approved an increase of \$2 in dues paid for AWSC membership. Dues will be \$12 for each member. The AWSC will be celebrating the 50 year anniversary at the March convention in Green Bay. Government officials, ISMA and ACSA officials are being invited to the convention. The February issue of WSN magazine will have a 17-page special edition. Andy reported the ACSA calendar raffle had 91 winners from Wisconsin in 2018.

Membership – Andy gave the membership totals for the club. Thank you to all our members and business members for renewing their membership. Welcome to all the students from the Snowmobile Safety Class to Bear Point Sno-Cruisers.
