## **BEAR POINT SNO-CRUISERS ANNUAL MEETING**

**September 18, 2021**

The Board of Directors met at 12:00 PM and reviewed the Sno-Cruisers By-Laws. The by-law language will be submitted to the membership at a special meeting to be held prior to the October meeting for approval by the membership. The special meeting will be at 10:00 AM with the regular meeting being held immediately following.

Mack McKim called the annual meeting to order at 1:05 PM.

Officers Present: Mack McKim, Ken Boren, Gary Harrington, Ron Rost, Andy Malecki, Jr., and members of Sno-Cruisers.

Minutes: Motion by Troy Frank, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pam Materniak, to approve the minutes as mailed. Passed.

President's Report: Mack reported on the meeting held by the Board on the By-Laws that will be submitted at the special meeting in October. Road clean-up (if weather permits) will take place after the regular meeting with lunch provided.

Vice President's Report: No report.

Treasurer's Report: The monthly financial report was given by Andy, along with the club's annual financial report. Motion by Troy Frank, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mary Kay Thomson, to accept reports. Passed.

Committee Reports: Alliance – The snowmobile alliance is finishing the county snowmobile map to be taken to the printer. Clubs are starting to work on getting equipment ready and brushing trails for the upcoming snow season. The Near North Trail Riders has received approval for a trail project that was submitted to the Governor's Council. The Blue Mounds trail approval is being appealed in court.

Legislative – Hearings were held in Madison on the 40 ft trail rule, headlight issues, and sound issues. The Governor's Snowmobile Council met in August and approved most projects that were submitted. The Council also set aside \$1 million for storm damage, \$200,000 for GPS trackers in club groomers, and funded 484 additional miles to the state funded trail system.

Membership – The club's membership numbers were given by Andy. Thank you to all who have renewed your memberships!

Clothes – Call Mary McKim to order club apparel at 715-927-4483.

Safety Class – Ron Rost has done the filings for the Club's snowmobile safety class. There will be two classes held on December 27 and December 28 at the Wausaukee Village Hall. Each class will have 10 students. If our club members have students wanting to take the class, sign up early on "Wisconsin Go Wild" as the class size is limited.

Communication: The club received a thank you from Pastor Fred's Food Pantry for the monetary donation to them. We also received notice of the Club's insurance premium for the upcoming club season.

Elections: President McKim made three calls for the nomination for Vice President. Ken Boren was nominated at the August meeting. Ken accepted the nomination. Hearing no new nominations, a motion was made by Sharon Partl, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Troy Frank, to have the secretary cast a unanimous ballot for Ken Boren. Passed.
