Minutes: Motion by Sharon Partl, 2nd by Jill Fisher, to approve the minutes as mailed. Passed.

President's Report: Mack stated the snowmobile trails are closing for the season.

Vice President's Report: No report.

Treasurer's Report: Andy gave the club's monthly financial report. Motion by Ron Rose, 2nd by Norm Ward, to accept report. Passed. The club's Class B raffle license has been received.

Committee Reports: Alliance – The Alliance members held their meeting in the new Wausaukee Village Hall. Discussion was held on trail reporting problems with Pete Vidas (County Snowmobile Administrator) and the situation has been resolved. Pete also stated all new trail projects need to be requested by April 15 to the DNR. The tourism people were in attendance and handed out the new county visitor guides and also stated the county has received the AWSC designation as a “Snowmobile Friendly County”. The award will be given out at the AWSC Convention on March 26. Nominations for Alliance officers were submitted as follows: County AWSC Director – Jeff Schaller; Alliance President – Andy Malecki, Jr. and Pat Mullarky; Vice President – Kelly Barnes; Secretary/Treasurer – Patti Mullarky. Nominations and elections will be held at the April meeting. Motion by Ken Boren, 2nd by Ron Rost, to have the club support Andy for Alliance President. Passed. The county's two recreation officers were in attendance and gave their patrol report. The county did not record any fatalities and as of this newsletter there had been 14 fatalities in the state.

Membership – The club's monthly membership report was given by Andy.

Road clean-up – Ron Rost stated the spring road clean-up will be held after the April meeting if weather conditions permit. We can use help and lunch will be provided afterwards.

Communications - The Red Solo Cup X-mas donation of \$600 was sent to Pastor Fred's Food Pantry. The Easter egg tree is up and an Easter egg can be purchased to hang on the tree with donations going to the Food Pantry.
